Year 4 Charlie B-S for his enthusiastic participation in Forest School and Evelyn for her consistent achievements in

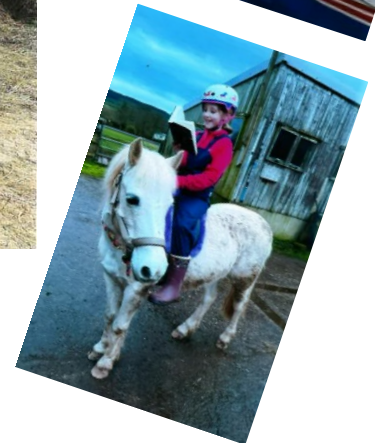
Number Sense activities.
