Year 3 Egyptian Day

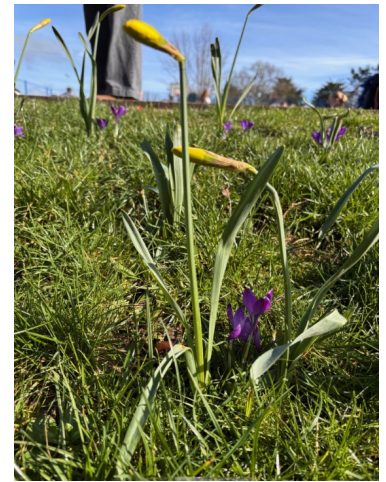
